

BELIZE:

ORDER made by the Public Utilities Commission in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Commission by the Belize Telecommunications Act, Chapter 229 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2020, and under the Telecommunications (Licensing Classification, Authorisation, and Fee Structure) Regulations, 2020 as amended, all other powers thereunto the Commission enabling.

Short title. 1. This Order may be cited as the:

REVOCATION OF GENERAL AUTHORISATION AND CLASS LICENCE OF BROADBAND BELIZE LIMITED, 2024 (NO. 1 OF 2024, TELECOMMUNICATIONS SECTOR).

WHEREAS:

- (A) On the 12th day of September, 2006 the Public Utilities Commission ("*the Commission*") in the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 15 of the Belize Telecommunications Act, Chapter 229 of the Substantive Laws of Belize ("*the Act*") and in accordance with Regulations 4 and 6 of the Telecommunications (Licensing Classification, Authorisation, and Fee Structure) Regulations, ("*the Regulations*") issued a General Authorisation to BROADBAND BELIZE LIMITED for the Provision of Carrier Services;
- (B) In accordance with section 15 of the Act and pursuant to the General Authorisation, BROADBAND BELIZE LIMITED ("*the Licensee*") was granted a Class Licence for the Provision of Carrier Services on certain terms and conditions ("*the Class Licence*");
- (C) By correspondence to the Commission received on 27th day of March, 2024, the Licensee formally notified the Commission that the Licensee has ceased to operate and that all areas previously serviced by them are now operated by Southern Cable Network Limited ("*SCN*").
- (D) In light of the above, the Commission hereby makes the following Order:

ORDER


- (1) Pursuant to Section 19 of the Belize Telecommunications Act, Chapter 229 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2020, the Public Utilities Commission hereby revokes both the General Authorisation and Class Licence granted to

Orders.

BROADBAND BELIZE LIMITED for the Provision of Carrier Services.

- (2) The revocation of the General Authorisation and Class Licence hereunder shall be without prejudice to the rights and remedies of the Commission to recover any fees, fines or other amounts due either now or in the future under the Act.
- (3) This Order shall take effect on the 29th day of August, 2024.
