PUC PROPOSES TO GRANT AN INDIVIDUAL LICENCE TO SPEEDNET COMMUNICATIONS LIMITED

The Public Utilities Commission (PUC) hereby notifies the public that a review of Speednet Communications Limited (SCL) application for an Individual Licence has been completed, and the Commission is proposing to grant a Licence to SCL.

The Commission's consideration is in accordance with the authorities outlined in the Belize Telecommunications Act, Chapter 229 of the Laws of Belize, and the Telecommunications (Licensing Classification, Authorization, and Fee Structure), Regulations, Revised Edition 2020 (as amended).

The Commission's reasons for granting SCL an Individual Licence include:

- Ongoing efforts to encourage a competitive environment leading to better services and lower prices for consumers.
- Increased geographical coverage of telecommunications services, particularly in unserved and underserved communities across Belize.
- Fostering innovation and adoption of new technologies in the telecommunications sector.
