Dear Sir,

We write in regards to the PUC published application by Belize Telemedia Limited on above subject and dated October 8, 2024.

Belize Telemedia’s application, if approved, assigns practically all currently available spectrum in the 6, 7 and 8 GHz bands to Caye Caulker and San Pedro and would effectively block Speednet from any meaningful capacity expansion in the future for its operations to the islands.

Therefore, it is imperative that Speednet also be able to apply for spectrum in these radio bands to meet its network capacity demands.

In fact, Speednet will be submitting application for spectrum in the same bands in the next couple of weeks. If BTL’s application is approved in its current form, this would inherently deny Speednet the opportunity to have its application considered and hopefully approved.
