

PUC Proposes to Grant Electricity Licences to Persons Under Various Categories

In accordance with the Electricity Licensing and Consent Regulations, as outlined in Statutory Instrument (S.I) No. 39 of 2024, the Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission") hereby notifies the general public that it intends to grant Electricity Licences to applicants under the following categories:

Licence Category	Licence Class	Licence Applicant

Reasons for Proposal to Grant the Electricity Licences:

- a) **Major Distributed Generation** - to allow the generation of electricity by a person primarily to meet their own peak demand, with the allowance to sell any excess energy generated to Belize Electricity Limited (BEL). This class of licence applies to systems with a generation capacity greater than 250 kWe and less than 1 MWe, and may include energy storage capacity not exceeding 4 MWh, as defined by the regulations issued by the Commission.
- b) **Intermediate Self-Generation and Supply** - to allow the generation of electricity by a person solely for their own use, with the entire output dedicated exclusively to self-supply. The generation capacity thresholds for this class of licence are defined by regulation and shall not exceed: (a) 1 MW for onshore renewable energy generation; (b) 0.25 MW for renewable energy generation in or near aquatic ecosystems; and (c) 2 MW for combined heat and power generation.
