## PUC Proposes to Grant Two Electricity Licences for Major Distributed Generation

In accordance with Statutory Instrument (S.I.) 39 of 2024, the Public Utilities Commission (**the "Commission"**) hereby notifies the general public that it intends to grant **Electricity License** to an applicant as follows:

### Reason for Proposal to Grant the Electricity Licence:

**Major Distributed Generation** - to allow the generation of electricity by a person primarily to meet their own peak demand, with the allowance to sell any excess energy generated to Belize Electricity Limited (BEL). This class of licence applies to systems with a generation capacity greater than 250 kWe and less than 1 MWe, and may include energy storage capacity not exceeding 4 MWh, as defined by the regulations issued by the Commission.
