PUC Proposes to Update National Spectrum Allocation Plan

In accordance with section 12 of the Belize Telecommunications Act, Chapter 229 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2020 (**"the Act"**), the Public Utilities Commission (**the "Commission"**) hereby notifies the public of its intention to introduce the Belize National Spectrum Allocation Plan 2026 (**the "Spectrum Plan"**) which will consist of the Belize National Frequency Allocation Table (**"NFAT"**).

The Commission is responsible for the control, planning, administration, management and licensing of the use of the radio frequency spectrum, and may from time to time, prepare a spectrum allocation plan pursuant to section 12(3) of the Act.

The proposed update to the NFAT is intended to align Belize's national frequency allocations with the latest provisions of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) Radio Regulations (2024 Edition), including the outcomes of the World Radiocommunication Conference 2023 (WRC-23), and to ensure continued consistency with international spectrum management practices.
