Public Consultation – PUC Proposes to Revise Terms and Conditions for the “Licence to All Persons”

The Public Utilities Commission (PUC) hereby notifies the public of a consultation on the proposed revised Terms and Conditions for the “Licence to All Persons”, in accordance with the Electricity Licensing and Consent Regulations, 2026, which came into effect on May 5, 2026.

The 2026 Regulations introduced two new electricity licence classes under the Licence to All Persons category:

- Intermediate Self-Generation and Supply; and
- Intermediate Distributed Generation.

As a result, the PUC proposes to revise the licence terms to facilitate lawful participation in these activities within defined technical, safety, and operational parameters. The revised terms will also continue to apply to the existing classes of:

- Backup Generation and Supply;
- Minor Self-Generation and Supply; and
- Minor Distributed Generation.
