Dear Chairman Molina,

RE: Submission of COP Adjustment Tariff Filing – August 2026 (\$0.0151/kWh)

BEL submits for the Commission's review and approval its application for a Cost of Power Adjustment (COPA) Tariff of \$0.0151 per kWh, proposed for implementation in August 2026, in accordance with the Terms and Conditions of the Regulatory Sandbox for the Cost of Power Adjustment Tariff, as outlined in Schedule 6C in the Final Decision -2026 Annual Review Proceedings.

Given the timing of the Final Decision, BEL respectfully requests the Commission's consideration regarding the filing timeline for this month. The Final Decision was issued on 17 July 2026, after the prescribed filing window. As such, this initial submission reflects the earliest practicable filing following the Decision. BEL confirms that all subsequent filings will comply with Schedule 6C, Section 8(a), and will be submitted no later than fifteen (15) days after the end of each month.

This filing is supported by the required documentation to substantiate the proposed adjustment. The submission includes the following:

1. Sales Report

A detailed report capturing the number of customers in each Customer Class, along with corresponding revenues and energy sold by tariff block.

2. Dispatch Report

A comprehensive report detailing hourly energy supplied, with corresponding costs by source and in aggregate; and a breakdown of pricing for electricity imports from Mexico (CFE) and generation from thermal power plants.

3. IPP Invoices

Copies of invoices issued by Independent Power Producers (IPPs), corresponding to the costs and sources reflected in the Dispatch Report.

4. Validation Reports

Monthly reconciliation reports validating IPP invoices and setting out detailed cost information for Licensee-owned power plants, including transactions & account listings.

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5. System Performance Reports

Reports on system losses and reliability for the applicable 6-month period.

6. COPA Calculation Schedule

A schedule outlining the derivation of the proposed COP Adjustment Tariff.

7. Customer Bill Impact Analysis

A schedule illustrating the estimated impact of the proposed COPA on representative customers across major customer classes.

As this is the first application under the COPA mechanism, the filing does not include:

- Information on prior COPA applications, including cumulative balances or unrecovered amounts due to the five percent (5%) cap; and
- Customer enquiries or complaints relating to the COPA, bill presentation, or customer understanding.

BEL remains committed to ensuring transparency and accuracy in the recovery of power supply costs. Should any additional information or clarification be required, we remain available to assist.
